HOME TUITION TEACHER

Reporting To: Headteacher

Principal Accountabilities

1. Teach individuals or small groups in KS1-KS4 who are receiving education other than at school according to current legislation. This will be delivered at the students' home or in other suitable locations such as a library
2. Work at various locations throughout the Borough according to requirement.
3. Develop a suitable curriculum taking into account the needs of the individual student.
4. Plan and prepare appropriate resources for the students' needs.
5. Take responsibility for the planning and development of suitable resources
6. Work with a range of other professionals to support individual pupils and promote inclusion for all.
7. Ensure good communication with parents/carers and other professionals
8. Ensure consistent and effective liaison with the Home tuition Co-ordinator and each pupil's school if appropriate. Maintain liaison throughout the period of tuition
9. Ensure accurate records of attendance and achievement are kept on each pupil.
10. Send in weekly reports and complete attendance register.
11. Record and report any incident of inappropriate behaviour or concerns of any kind to the Head teacher and/or Designated Safeguarding Lead as felt necessary in accordance with guidelines.
12. Attend meetings where necessary.
13. Take responsibility for your own professional development needs in consultation with the Head teacher.
